

REMEMBER THAT...

Present perfect	Past perfect
<p>An action or circumstance that began in the past and persists into the present. For example, I have resided in Bristol since 1984, indicating that I moved there in 1984 and continue to live there up to the present moment.</p> <p>Grammar:</p>  <p>Remember: when the subject is in third person (He, She and It), we have to use "has". For example:</p> <p>She has cut the pear.</p> <p>In this topic, we need to use past participle verbs, so it is important to know them.</p>	<p>The past perfect tense is a grammatical construction used to indicate an action that occurred before another action in the past. It is formed by combining the auxiliary verb "had" with the past participle of the main verb.</p> <p>Grammar:</p> <div style="background-color: #ffffcc; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 5px;"> <p>To make an affirmative, we use the following formula, Subject + had + past participle + object</p> </div> <div style="background-color: #ccffcc; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 5px;"> <p>To make a negative sentence, we use the following formula, Subject + had not + past participle + object</p> </div> <div style="background-color: #ccffff; padding: 5px;"> <p>In order to ask questions, we use the following formula, Had + subject + past participle + object</p> </div> <p>Remember: We write "had" in all subjects. For example:</p> <p>She had driven in her trip. I had written a book.</p> <p>In this topic, we need to use past participle verbs, so it is important to know them.</p>
